Mafalda DiMango has been a member of the local school board for more than 40 years. Her involvement with educational issues began when she served as president of the PTA at P.S. 204 back in the early 1960s. She was appointed to a seat on Community School Board 20 a few years later.

In 1969, when the state education law was changed and school board seats became elected posts, DiMango ran for a seat and won. She was re-elected several times.

In 2002, the law was changed again and community education councils were created. The panels are composed of parents, but two seats on each board are appointed by the borough president. Borough President Marty Markowitz appointed DiMango to the Community Education Council of District 20.
